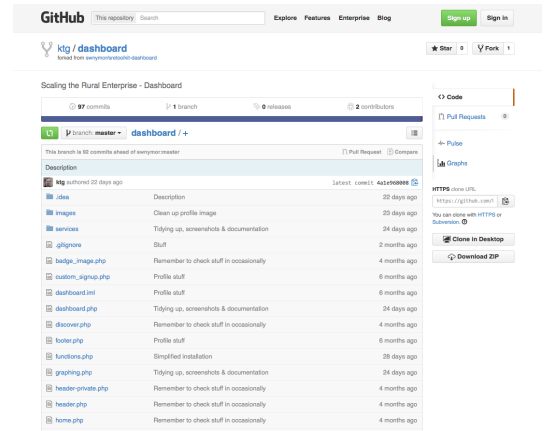




1. Download the Dashboard source code

Visit <https://github.com/ktg/dashboard> and download the zip file, in the right-hand side column. Alternatively, you can clone to repository with HTTPS or Subversion: <https://github.com/ktg/dashboard.git>



2. Download Wordpress and install it on a server

You will need to have your own web server set up, which supports PHP and MySQL (e.g. a web server running Apache or Nginx works well). Download Wordpress from wordpress.org and install it on your server. You can use the Wordpress 5 minute installation guide for more information: http://codex.wordpress.org/Installing_WordPress

3. Upload the Dashboard source code into Wordpress

The Dashboard source code works as a Wordpress theme. After you've installed Wordpress on your server, you will need to navigate to the Themes folder (httpdocs -> wp-content -> themes) and upload the Dashboard folder there. Log in to your Wordpress website, using a web browser and activate the Dashboard Theme. Done!

Alternatively, you can install the Dashboard theme in a web browser. Go to your Wordpress website, log in as the administrator and go to Appearance -> Themes. Select 'Add New', select 'Upload Theme', select 'Choose File', and find and select the dashboard zip that you downloaded. Select install now and then activate it. Done!
